Mollusks on stamps publications

Leslie A. Crnkovic

In 2015, while working on an exhibit "The Emperor's Shell," featuring the slit shell Mikadotrochus hirasei, I learned the shell has its own postage stamp (Japan 4¥ 1963). This led to my collecting the stamp and its first day covers (FDC), 44 so far, and also seeking



books about seashells on postage stamps. Those FDC are a future articles topic.

Tom Rice (Thomas C. Rice)

Having a 5th Edition of Rice's *Checklist of the Mollusks on Postage Stamps*, I reached out to Tom, and he helped me on my 'Shelling on Stamps' adventures. Tom was well known for his many publications, most notably "Rice's Prices" and *Of Sea and Shore Magazine* (OS&S), plus his OS&S Museum in Port Gamble, WA. It appears that in 1976 Tom Rice was the first to create a 'topical' publication covering mollusks on postage stamps.

This paper is dedicated in honor of Tom Rice (1939–2022), a man I considered a mentor, friend, and my hero of shell publications. I mourn his passing.

Fond Recollections

Tom and I first started communicating when I became a book dealer in the late 1980's and sold his books. He was always happy to help me in the craft. I really enjoyed the OS&S back issues until it restarted in 1990, then through its end in 2007.

At the 2002 COA convention, I was blessed to roommate with him, and to meet up with him at the 2019 Sheller's Convention in Siquijor, Philippines.

Mollusks on Postage Stamps Facebook Page

In 2015 Tom and I started a Facebook group page "Mollusks on Postage Stamps," which he curated until his passing. The page is now managed by John Jacobs and others. We encourage you to visit the site, which is still active. You can post images and info related to the site topic. Tom Walker (Thomas M. Walker)

As I recall, Tom and I met at the 2001 COA convention, perhaps on a field trip. At another convention, I acquired his 2008 Stamp CD. As I continued to collect the various shell stamp books, I contacted Tom Walker to learn more, and he provided several books and insights, building some of the library listed herein. At the end of 2007, Tom stopped stamp collecting, wrapping it up with publication of the last CD revision in 2008. He also provided the stamp images herein and corrected a few of the typos.

Stamp Collecting

Writing about stamp collecting is the subject for entire books; however, a few terms will be helpful:

Philately – the hobby of collecting stamps.

- **Topical** the term applied to stamps on a specific topic such as: shells, flowers, cats, the Olympics, national parks, sports, presidents, flags, etc.
- **Thematic** collecting of both stamps of a certain topic and related items such as proofs, specimens, info sheets, Cinderella stamps, bogus, etc.
- **Major vs. Minor Designs** when the mollusk is the primary subject (major) vs. a small part (minor) of the overall design.
- **Bogus** philatelic fakes and forgeries, stamps that are fake reproductions or a design created pretending to be a real postal stamp, etc.
- **Cinderella stamp** virtually anything resembling a postage stamp, but not issued for postal purposes, such as those printed by a government for other uses, or for promotional use by businesses, churches, political or non-profit groups. Excludes stamps imprinted on postal stationery.
- **Concho-philately vs. malacophilately** are terms applied to collecting seashells on stamps but are not used much outside of the originating books and a few collectors. It incurs the same challenge as: conchology vs. malacology, or only shells vs. all mollusks. (See: Arakawa 1979, & Emmerich 1980)
- **First day of issue cancellation mark** a special stamp cancellation image created for the release of a stamp from a specific post office location.
- **First day covers (FDC)** a decorative envelope 'cover' created as a collectable for the first day of issue of a stamp. Stamp designs are usually made public long before release so that the FDC makers can be ready for the release date.

Topical stamps on mollusks or shells refers to all mollusks: squids, slugs, nudibranchs, etc. The stamp could be about the shell, or just a shell included somewhere on the stamp. It is estimated that there are over 10,000 legitimate mollusk topical stamps, however, Topical Stamps also include Cinderella and bogus stamps. Cancellation marks for first day of issue may also include a shell.

pages across 4 issues. Across the 37-year span of OS&S magazine, there would be 60 issues with stamp listings, images and articles. The full listing is included later in this article.
